**Parent/Guardian Occupancy – NTR Newmarket

Parents/guardians are only allowed into the facility to tie skates. They must then exit the facility. Remaining in the arena viewing area is only allowed if the team going on the ice has 12 skaters or less going on the ice (players). There are designated spots along the glass for the parents to stand and remain 6 feet apart. The occupancy limit per pad is 22 including players, all staff, and parents.

***Coaches – NTR Newmarket

Coaches are not allowed into the rooms to change if there are 16 players skating. There can only be 8 people in a change room at once.
