

QUEEN OF THE HOUSE – 2023-24 TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. No pickup players are permitted. The only exception would be if the rostered goalie was not available to play for some reason. Any goalie replacement would have to be approved by the VP, House League of the team's Association.
- 2. OWHA and CHA rules will apply, except where listed below:

Hat trick rule: Max 3 goals will count for any one player per game (regulation, overtime) 3 penalties of any type will result in the removal of that player from the rest of the game.

- 3. Game duration: **U11 U15** 10-10-12 min and **U18** 12-12-15 min
- 4. In the event of a tie after regulation time, a 5 minute sudden death overtime with 4 skaters aside will be held. If still tied, proceed to a 3 player shootout. Shooters will shoot alternately starting with the Visitors and the team with the most goals will be the winner. If still tied, the shootout will continue in a sudden death format. The first team to score without the other team scoring will be the winner. No player may shoot twice until all players have had the opportunity to shoot. Any player in the penalty box at the end of overtime will NOT be eligible to participate in the shootout.
- 5. Each team has 1 timeout per game.
- 6. All decisions by the Referee are final with no option of appeal.
- 7. The Tournament Marshall reserves the right to alter any of the above rules in order to keep to schedule.
- 8. All Coaches will be required to provide their lineup and shift rotation plan to the Tournament Marshall prior to each game as per the Fair Ice Policy guidelines provided. The lineup will include designated forwards and defense and there will be NO changes allowed during the course of the game. The only exception would be due to injury, illness, or an equipment problem. Any team found to be in violation of the Fair Ice Policy by the Tournament Marshall shall be disqualified from the Tournament.
