HAVING LEFT MARIUPOL IN A HURRY, HIS FAMILY BARELY HAD TIME COLLECT THEIR PERSONAL BELONGINGS LET ALONE ANY SPORTS EQUIPMENT. MARK IS JUST ONE OF THE HUNDREDS OF KIDS WHO LEFT THEIR HOMES WITH NOTHING.
